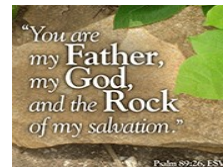
Through Bible stories, songs, skits, crafts and games, and a yummy lunch we will share the Good News that Jesus is the Rock!

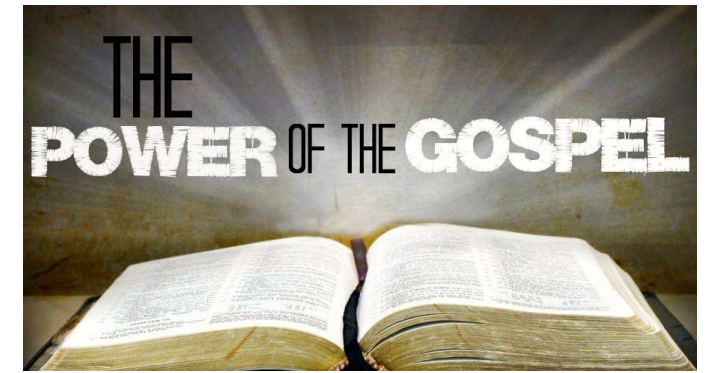
