

#### THE HEART OF MISSION GIVING



Central has had a long-standing history of supporting missions both locally and globally through our weekly giving opportunities. One of our United Methodist beliefs is to follow Christ's servant example by caring for the stranger and showing our compassion to those in need. Over the years we have supported many local and global organizations by selecting very worthy groups in our community, our state, our country, and in areas across the globe.

The Missions Team has worked with Pastor Rob to incorporate a new system beginning in July that will simplify our mission contributions. Each month there will be just one mission focus that will be selected for our contributions (12 per year). We will also have the opportunity to contribute to the Pastor's Helping Hand Fund each and every month. The monthly mission focus will support a local mission group like Hope Project or Kids' Food Basket or a global one such as UMCOR's Immigration, Law, and Justice—Michigan Project or Heifer International. It is our hope to make more of an impact on the main mission focus with more participation from our membership. After all, we remember 2 Corinthians 9:7 "...for God loves a cheerful giver."

Our giving envelopes will be updated to reflect the new system of the Mission of the Month and the Helping Hand Fund, both that you can contribute to at any time during each month. Envelopes will be available at the desk at the back of the Sanctuary or in the church office.
